

Calcitonin

IN VITRO DIAGNOSTIC DATASHEET

INTENDED USE: IN VITRO DIAGNOSTIC USE

This product is intended for qualitative immunohistochemistry with normal and neoplastic formalin-fixed, paraffin-embedded tissue sections, to be viewed by light microscopy. it is Rabbit Monoclonal.

DESCRIPTION: Calcitonin is a 32 amino acid peptide which can be demonstrated in C cells of the normal and hyperplastic thyroid. Staining for calcitonin may be used for the identification of a spectrum of C cell proliferative abnormalities ranging from C cell hyperplasia to invasive tumors. Staining for calcitonin in medullary carcinoma of the thyroid produces a fine granular pattern in the cytoplasm. Amyloid deposits within the tumor may also exhibit varying degrees of calcitonin activity.

PRETREATMENT: No special pretreatment is required for immuno-histochemistry of formalin-fixed tissues.

PRIMARY ANTIBODY INCUBATION TIME: 30 minutes at Room Temperature

STAINING TIPS: If the staining is too light, use lower dilution or longer time. If the staining is

too strong, check pretreatment, use higher dilution or shorter time.

STORAGE AND STABILITY: This product contains sodium azide and is stable for 24 months when stored

at 2-8°C. Do not use after expiration date indicated on label of the product. If reagent

is not stored as recommended, performance must be validated by the user.
